

## SuperESD - PESD2CAN,215-ES

## 1. Description

The PESD2CAN,215-ES is a Transient Voltage Suppressor Arrays that designed to protect components which are connected to data and transmission lines against electrostatic discharge (ESD), electrical fast Transients (EFT), and lightning. All pins are rated to withstand 30kV ESD pulses using the IEC61000-4-2 air discharge method.

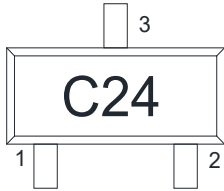

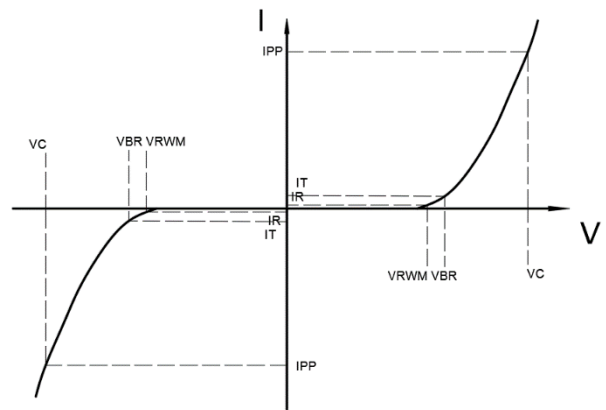

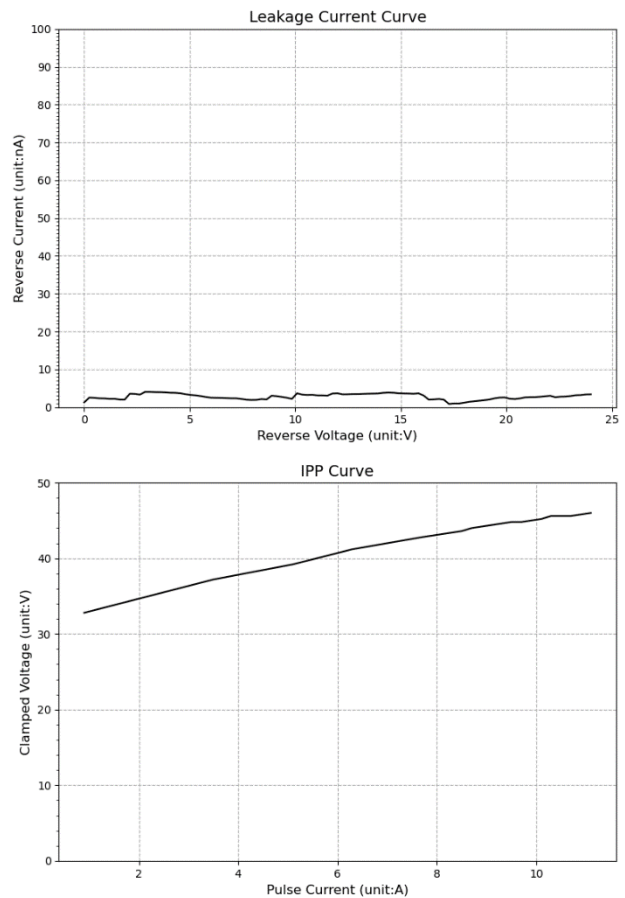

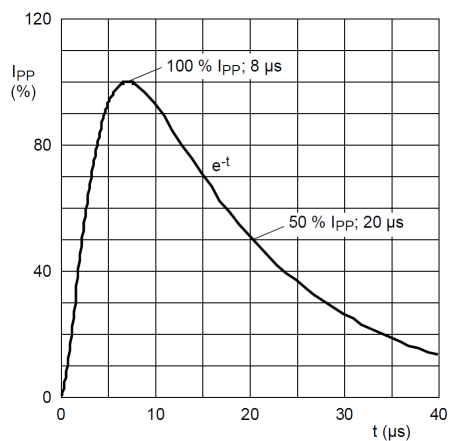

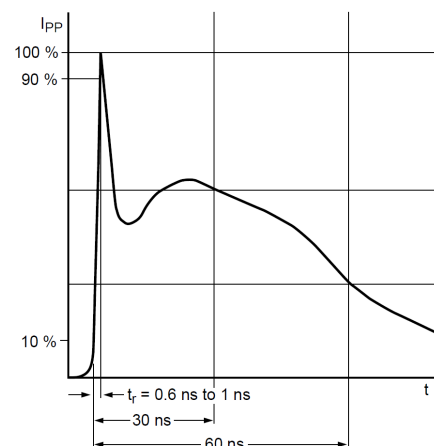

## Measurement Wave According to IEC Standard

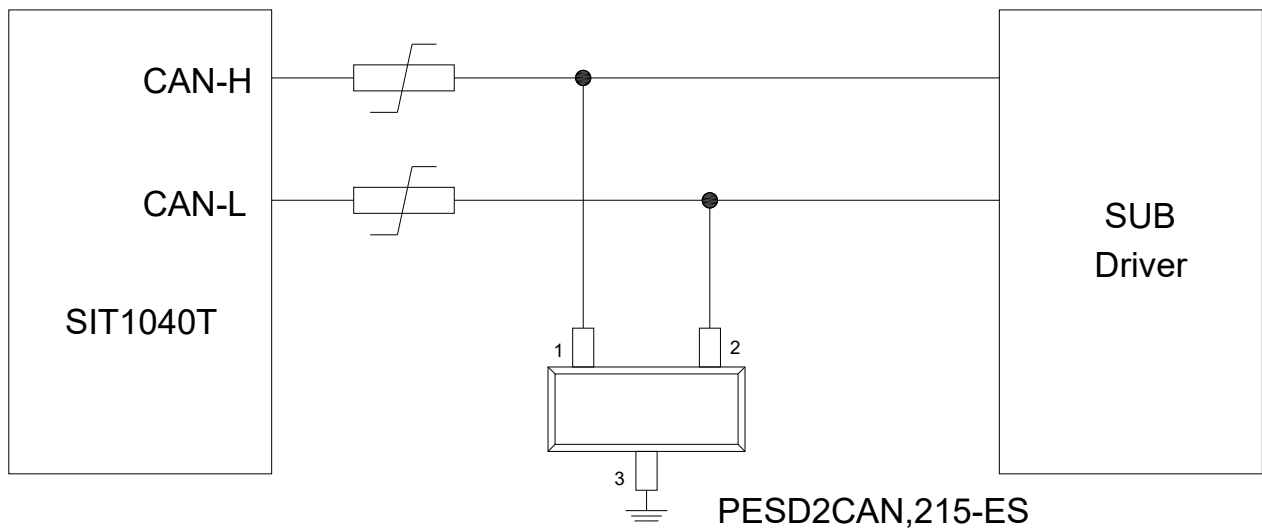


8/20  $\mu$ s pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-5

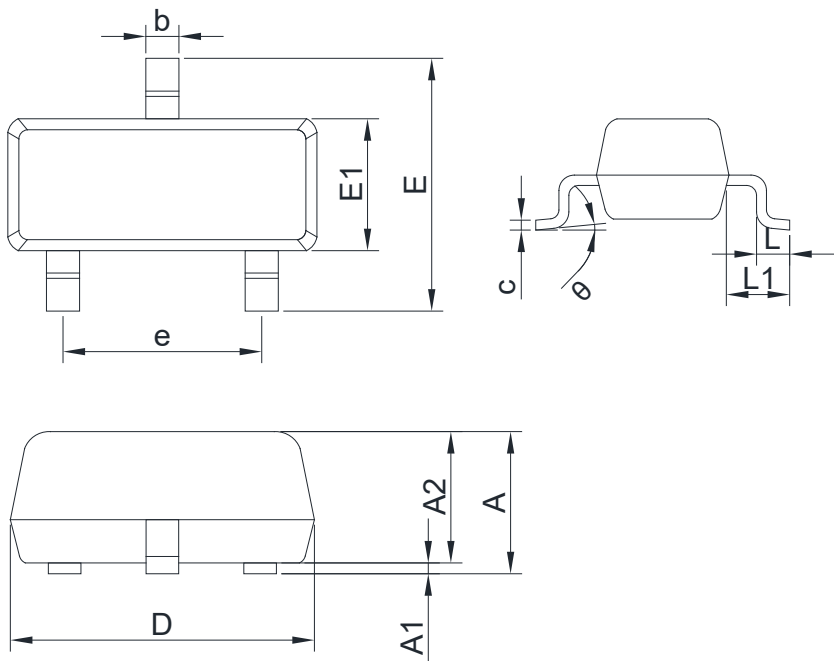
Typical Interface Application of CAN Bus Protection

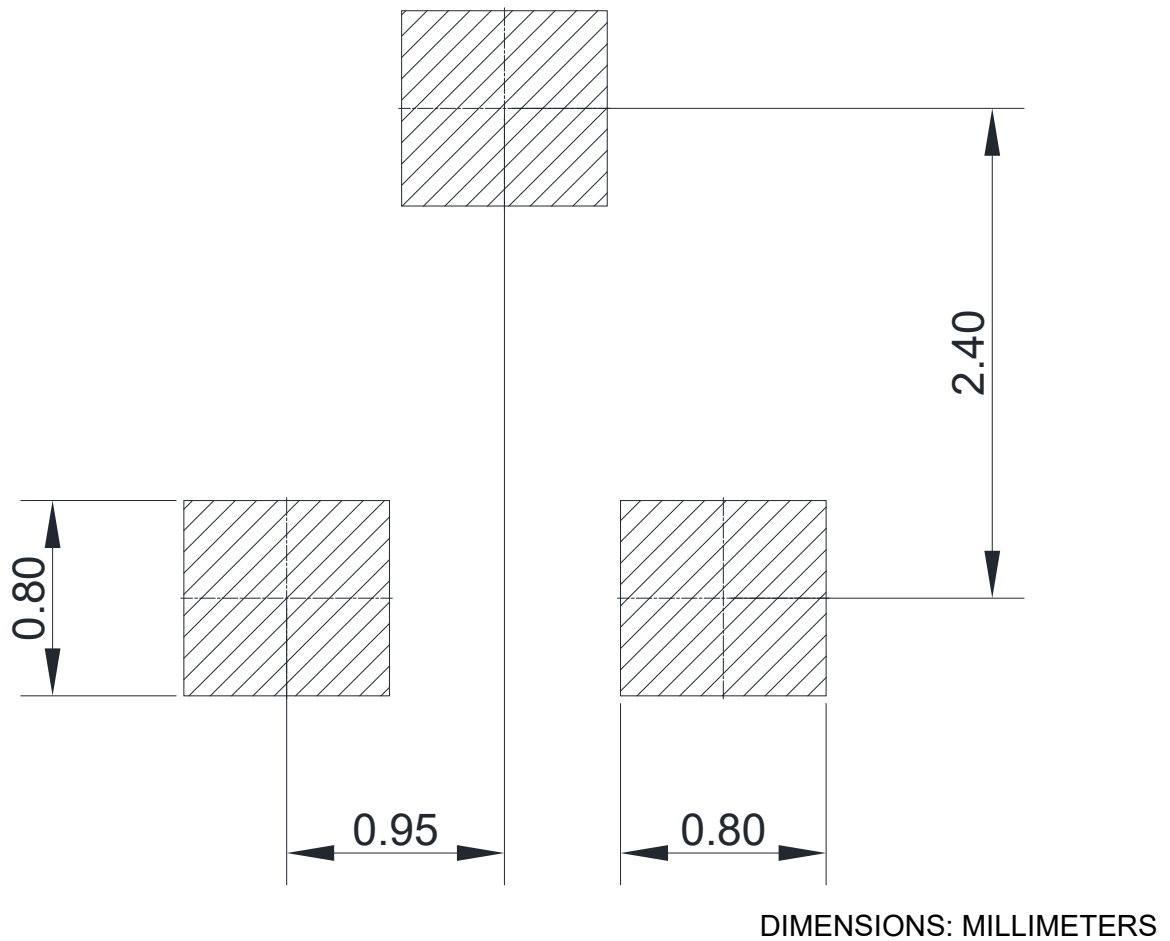
