2. Outline:

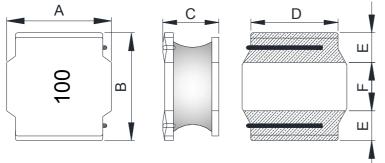
The products are used as choke coils for DC/DC converter and consist of drum core, coil, Magnetic Glue and terminals.

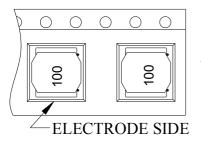


5.1.5. Packing Style of Taping (Unit: mm)



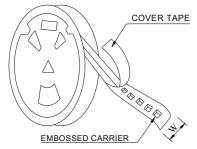

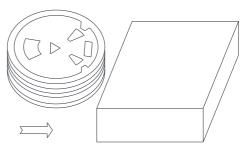

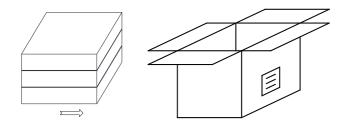
